PARK INFORMATION

WELCOME

On behalf of all staff and management, we thank you for staying at Whyalla Caravan & Tourist Park. If you have any issues please do not hesitate to contact us. We kindly ask that you abide by all rules to ensure everyone has a safe and enjoyable stay.

FEES

All fees must be paid during check in unless prior arrangements have been made. We offer payment via phone, EFTPOS, cash and invoicing.

CHECK OUT

All guests must check out at 10am unless you are a night shift worker or have redeemed a GDAY rewards Late Check Out Benefit in which you must check out by 12pm.

SPEED LIMIT

The speed limit around the park is 10 km/hour. Usual road rules apply. Bike and scooter users must wear a helmet at all times and must not enter areas that are marked with signage.

VISITORS

All visitors must report to reception upon entering the park. Visitors must not stay past 10pm unless prior arrangements are made. All damage done by visitors to any part of the park are the responsibility of the guests and be charged for any damages made.

NOISE

Excessive noise is not permitted. All noise must cease after 10pm and minimal noise is to be made near the workers area at all times. Any abusive, excessive drunkenness or inappropriate behaviour can result in you vacating the park or relevant authorities called.

DAMAGE

Any damage made to the park will be charged to the responsable guest.

Any damage made by pets are the responsability of the guest.

FIRE EQUIPMENT

It is against the law to remove, damage, interfere with or obstruct fire alarms, smoke alarms or fire extinguishers. Penalties apply.

SMOKE FREE AREAS

Smoke free areas include amenities blocks, laundry, reception, all camp kitchens, playground, dog park and all other facilities. Smoking is also not permitted in onsite accomodation and sites.

PARK FACILITES

Children under 13 must be supervised at all times around the park. Our facilities are free for guest and visitor use only. Campfires are only permitted in our fire pit located at the outdoor camp kitchen. All fires lit must be not within the fire ban season and management must be notified before lighting the fire.

BINS

Rubbish must be bagged and placed in red bins provided throughout the park. Place cans, glass and plastic bottles in blue receptacles located next to the outside bins. Cardboard must be placed in yellow bins.

Park patrons enter this park and use our facilities at their own risk. The park accept no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any person or property. Our Cancellation policy applies if you decide to leave early. All people in this property are subject to photography for marketing or other purposes deemed by management.

PETS

Pets are only permitted in our pet friendly accommodation and are not to be left unattended in cabins. Pets are permitted in sites but must be on a lead at all times. Pets aren't permitted in any park facilities and all droppings must be bagged and placed in bins.

GREY WATER DISPOSAL

Grey Water can be disposed in the garden but please ensure it is not disposed directly on plants. Some sites have drains that can also be used for disposal.
